

Master in European Studies: EU Institutions and Public Policy

Introduction

The Master in European Studies: EU Institutions and Public Policy (MES) is a oneyear program aimed at training future experts in European Union affairs, EU institutions and international organizations. This highly professionalizing full-time program provides students with broad yet specific proficiencies in the working procedures of European institutions and in policy areas linked with the EU, such as Migration, Security, Euro-Zone Politics and the Common Market. Combining theoretical and practical approaches, the program enables students to understand the political. economic and cultural dynamics among the EU actors, as well as between the EU and external actors, while getting an excellent preparation for a career with institutions, organizations and private employers.

Objectives

The course prepares future professionals for careers in:

- Policy analysis
- European institutions and international organizations
- Private companies acting on the international stage

Participants

MES is a first-level master's program. Applicants are required to hold at least a three-year bachelor's degree in Political Science, Economics, Law, Humanities, Philosophy or neighboring disciplines, including languages. For all other fields, the selection board reserves the right to an individual examination of the

candidate's suitability for the program. Classes are small, with a maximum of 25 students, allowing for interactive teaching and individual supervision of each student.

Career Opportunities

Graduates of the program can apply for jobs in European and international institutions such as the EU Commission. the EU Parliament or the ECB. the United Nations with its numerous sub-organizations worldwide, NGOs, and companies that operate internationally. The Luiss Career Service offers specialized training for successful job applications and provides individual contacts in order to apply for internships. An EPSO training course prepares candiates for the highly competitive selection process to European institutions.

Program Description

The Master in European Studies consists of:

- Four core courses
- Six elective courses
- Training and simulation exercises
- Final master's thesis

Core courses:

- Luropean Politics after 1945
- Reforming European
 Institutions and Democracy
- European Macroeconomics
- Policies and Policymaking in the EU

Specialized Training

The programs gives students the opportunity to attend technical courses to successfully access and operate within European institutions.

This includes training in academic methodology and communication in order to prepare students for research, writing and public transmission techniques. Students may also choose between two-day preparatory courses such as EPSO, a specialized training in Learning Policy Advise or EU Programming, focused on the managing projects funded by the EU.

Career Service

A dedicated Career Service Office supports students' future employment focusing on three objectives:

- I providing students training and tools in order to be effective in their employment search

Students are offered two different career programs according to their seniority and objectives:

Junior Program – for students first entering the job market interested in curricular internships. The program includes employability training, individual career guidance sessions and active promotion of students to fill vacant internships.

Senior Program - for older students with professional experience interested in exploring different career paths. The program includes: employability training, individual career guidance sessions, soft skills training. The Career Service Office is also available to support students in:

- preparation for important job interviews
- internships
- decision-making related to specific professional choices
