

JOINT MASTER IN EU TRADE & CLIMATE DIPLOMACY

The Joint Master in EU Trade and Climate Diplomacy aims to develop strong analytical and negotiation skills through evidence-based learning and practical project work in key areas of the program: Sustainability and Climate, Trade and Investment, Digital and Security Cooperation.

The curriculum focuses on how to act, reflect, and engage effectively in strategic trade, security and climate policy negotiations between Europe and other global powers, using a wide range of policy and digital intelligence tools.

OBJECTIVES

The program equips students with critical thinking skills and first-hand experience of how EU institutions and decision-making processes work, and how to work with them now and in the near future in the public, non-profit and private sectors.

Graduates will be able to work across a wide range of fields, including policy analysis, security analysis, trade and economic development, foreign affairs and diplomacy, international finance, digital policy, and environmental policy.

ADMISSION REOUIREMENTS

Students must have obtained a three-year bachelor's degree

Documentation required for online application

- detailed CV
- motivation letter explaining the candidate's interest in the program
- university transcript
- one reference letter (or contact of a potential referee)
- where applicable, a certificate of English proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS or by another recognized language institute)
- a copy of the applicant's national identity card or passport
